Research and Innovation Supporting Clean Energy Transition: Challenges and Opportunities

Research and Innovation (R&I) is a key pillar of the European policy for Clean Energy Transition. However, the total national R&I expenditure varies from country to country with Sweden in the first place to Eastern and Southern European countries lagging behind EU average. Similarly, the "old European" countries are performing considerably better in terms of attracting European funds, such as Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe.
